Write a 'How to Look After My Pet' Guide. Add photographs or drawings. If you don't have a pet write about a favourite animal.



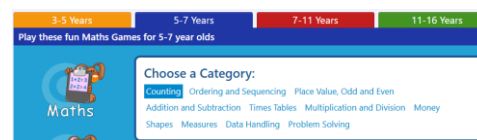
RE Easter

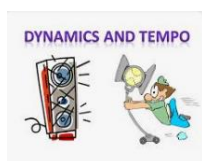


Maths
