#### How do Muslims Live?

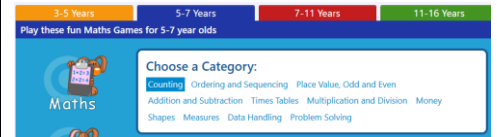
The Mosque is a special place of worship for Muslims.

Make a mud face for a tree! Make your own mud or use clay or playdough.

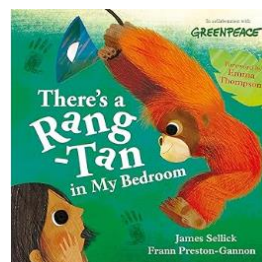
Decorate with other natural objects. Stick to a tree

We have been learning about palm oil in our Literacy lessons and will be reading this book.

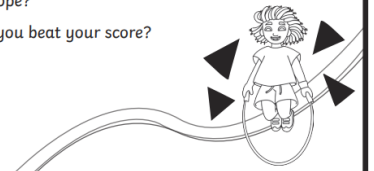
Write a fact file about orangutans or another endangered animal that lives in forests.



### PE

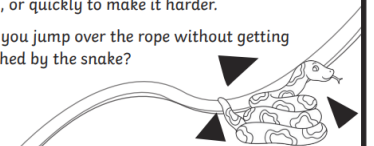
#### Skipping
