Unfortunately it looks like colder and wetter weeks ahead weather wise, so please send in coats every day along with gloves and hats.

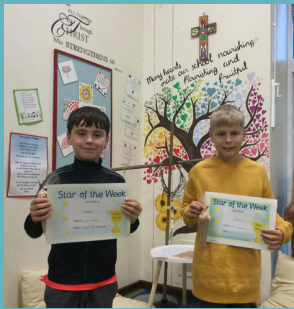

This week EYFS had a whole morning of Forest School and selected Y1/2 groups had some time in the afternoon. It was a brilliant day and the children loved their time outside.



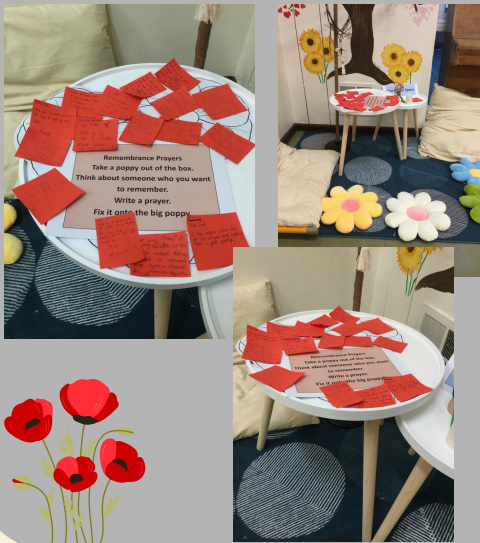
Antibullying Week
