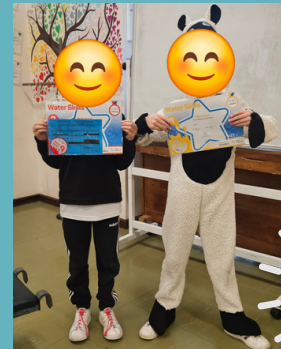
Next week we have the fun of Wheelchair Sports for Y1-6
