*"I am the vine and you are the branches. If you stay joined to me, and I to you, you will produce plenty of fruit." John 15:5*

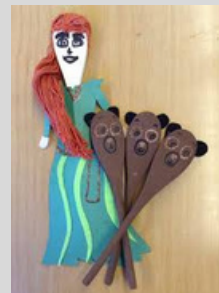
## World Book day - Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March

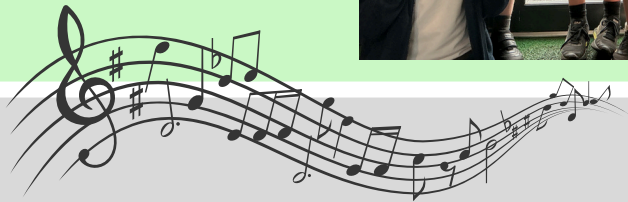
3. As always, the day will be filled with book related activities and the children are welcome to bring in their favourite book to share.
