We enjoyed seeing so many creative ideas for our storybook spoons competition and we all loved looking at them all!

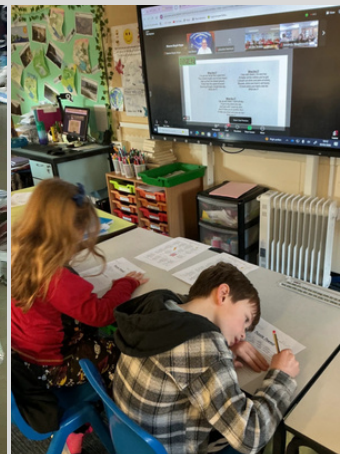
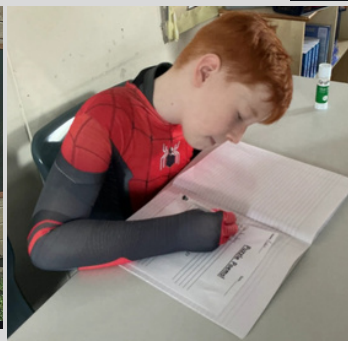
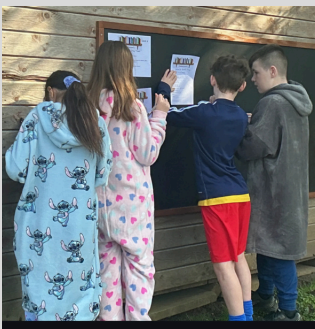
