Hazel Class

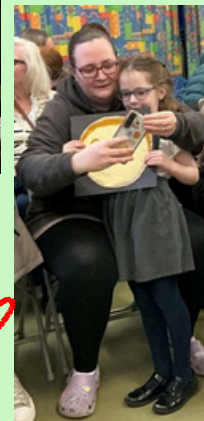
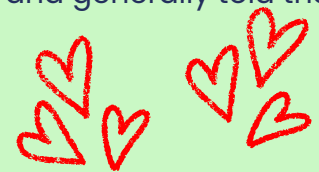
