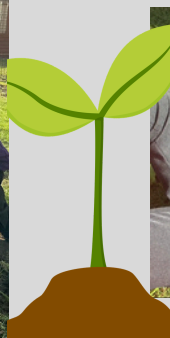
Easter Worship
